November 24, 1938 - October 30, 2013

Robert "Bob" Arthur Walsh, 74, passed away surrounded by his family at Jupiter Medical Center on the morning of October 30th 2013, as a result of a series of illnesses.

Bob was born an Irish Massachusetts boy. He always brimmed a wide smile, to all he greeted. His patriotism and love of his country inspired him to join the United States Air Force, where he served honorably and with distinction with the Strategic Air Command.
