



Ronald Henry Marhoffer

November 30, 1940 - August 27, 2016

Ronald Henry "Ron" Marhoffer, husband of Mildred "Mickie" Marhoffer of Tequesta, FL born 30 November 1940 in Rahway, NJ passed away peacefully on 27 August 2016 in the Hospice Care Center at Jupiter Medical Center Pavilion. He was raised in New Jersey. After graduating High School, he entered the United States Navy where he served on the Destroyer USS Bristol. He was united in holy matrimony to Mildred A. Currie on 26 August 1961. After honorable discharge from the Navy, he served in the Rahway Fire Department. In 1971 they relocated to Coral Springs, FL where he became a union certified carpenter. They relocated to Jupiter in 1977 and have lived in the Jupiter-Tequesta area since. Ron enjoyed self-employment as a residential contractor until 2002, when he joined the Jupiter Medical Center Building Engineering Department and finally retired from full-time employment in 2010. Ronald Henry is survived by his wife of 55 years and life-long partner Mildred "Mickie" Marhoffer, daughter Sharon & Son-in-law Jay Friant of Castle Rock, CO, Kim E.
