Bill will be fondly remembered as a loving family man who enjoyed dancing, especially the Jitterbug at family weddings. he took pleasure in fishing, sailing, boating, snorkeling, travelling, woodworking, and socializing with his many friends, and "two Bartlett fingers" of Scotch on ice.
