Thomas C. Fink, of Palm Beach Gardens went home to heaven on May 23, 2022. He was an adored husband, father, grandfather, and great grandfather who will be deeply missed. Thomas was born in Brooklyn, NY and moved to Florida in 1962 with his wife, Sally where he dedicated his life to selflessly raising his family and serving the Lord.

After being a claims manager for an insurance company, he became the Sales Director at Golden Lakes where he was named Sales and Marketing Director of the year for Florida Home Builders, in 1973. From 1975-1984 Tom owned and managed two A&W Drive-ins in Rivera and West Palm Beach. His life-long venture in commercial and residential real estate began when he founded, Concept One Reality, Inc. in the 1980's. Most recently he was president of PEO Pro, Inc. a professional employee leasing company.

He served in roles such as President of Rivera Beach Rotary Club where he raised money for benevolent causes; Board of Directors for North Palm Branch YMCA in Palm Beach Gardens; Deacon, usher, and Sunday school teacher at First Baptist Lake Park and West Palm Beach; and a recent member of the Gideon's. He was a dynamic Bible teacher loved by all who he taught. Thomas was a versatile athlete learning to play on the streets of Brooklyn. He played with the likes of Joe Torre and received scholarships to Butler County Community College and later Long Island University where he

excelled in basketball and baseball. While raising his family, Thomas started coaching in youth athletic leagues. He has coached two generations. As an avid sports fan he could be spotted at a local football or basketball games.
