Vincent Joseph Giannone, age 93, of Tequesta, passed away Monday, May 12, 2014 at Tequesta Terrace in Tequesta, Florida. Mr. Giannone was born November 26, 1920 in Brooklyn, New York to the late Joseph Giannone and Rosalie Giambalvo. He had been a resident of Jupiter since 1987 coming from Uniondale, New York once he retired from the Nassau Veterans Memorial Coliseum after fifteen years of service. Vincent was a veteran of WWII serving with the U.S. Army Air Corp as a Sargent.
