Karl Walter Ohnmacht (known as Walter), 89, died after a short illness at his home in Jupiter, FL on June 25, 2017. Walter Ohnmacht was born on March 20, 1928 in Somerville, NJ to parents William and Bertha Ohnmacht. As a youth he worked with his family at the Central Bakery in Somerville.
