



## William "Bill" W. Thomas

December 2, 1942 - January 19, 2019

Bill Thomas of Jupiter, Florida passed away on Saturday, January 19th, 2019 at the age of 76. Born in Kingston, PA to William Walter Thomas, Sr. and Jeanette Jones, he was raised in Edwardsville and graduated from Edwardsville High School in 1960. He was proud to have served his country in the Army in the late '60s. While living in Pennsylvania, he worked in the banking and finance industry. Bill, his wife Carol, and their children moved from Kingston to Jupiter in 1999. From then until 2016, they owned and operated West Jupiter Camping Resort in Jupiter Farms. Bill is best remembered for his outsized personality and love of Penn State football. He was a lifelong member of Kingston Lodge No. 395 of the Free and Accepted Masons, Shriners International, and the American Legion. You didn't have to know Bill well to know that his family and friends were the most important parts of his life.
