William Henry Faulhaber passed away peacefully in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, on September 23, 2023.

“Bill”, as he was known to friends and family, was born on July 22, 1931 in Crestline, Ohio, to Henry and Helen Faulhaber. He attended Lehman High School in Canton, Ohio and after graduation, his family relocated to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
